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7.1 Removing and installing high level brake light


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7.1.1 Removing and installing the high level brake light - Rapid

Removing

- Switch off the ignition and all electrical consumers!
- Consecutively press the retaining tabs in direction of arrow -A- and detach the cover -2- from the light housing -1- in direction of arrow -B-.



- Pinch the retaining tabs in the direction of arrow -A- and pull the brake light -1- in the direction of arrow -B- out of the support.
- Separate electrical plug connection -2-.


Installing

Installation is carried out in the reverse order.



Note

The light strip is fitted with LEDs, which cannot be replaced individually. In the event of a fault, the brake light must be replaced completely.



7.1.2 Removing and installing the high level brake light - Rapid Spaceback



Caution

When using the lever tool, mask points where the lever tool is applied using commercially available adhesive tape.

Special tools and workshop equipment required

- ◆ Disassembly wedge - T10383- , if necessary, plastic spatula
